DETERMINE YOUR ELIGIBILITY!

To vote in Pennsylvania you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have lived in Pennsylvania for at least 30 days
- Have been a US citizen for at least a month



REGISTER TO VOTE!

Eligible voters are required to register 30 days before the election

You can also register in person at a County Voter Registration Office or by mail.



LEARN ABOUT THE CANDIDATES!

Search the internet and news sources for information about the candidates. Email them to ask questions and learn more about the issues they support.

Use reliable sources of information. Check references in articles and websites, read more than one article, and try to learn about the authors' viewpoints.



VOTE!

To vote in person, you must go to your designated polling place in person on election day. In special circumstances, you may be able to use an absentee ballot.

It is recommended that you bring a form of identification.
